

CARMARTHEN CASTLE PHASE 4 ENHANCEMENT SCHEME CARMARTHENSHIRE

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

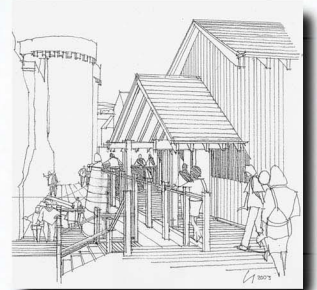
TACP have undertaken the conservation and enhancement of Carmarthen Castle over 4 phases during the past decade. The Castle, the majority of which is a Scheduled Ancient Monument, has been restored and consolidated.

The Phase 4 works maintain the three key objectives of the overall Enhancement Scheme, namely:-

1. Opening up the Castle to the public
2. Enhancement of the Castle
3. Expanding awareness and interpretation of the castle

Phase 4 will provide:

- The Castle Concourse. This will form an intimate and flexible space acting as an arrival point to the castle Gate Towers. It will also be capable of supporting organised activities such as mediaeval fairs, exhibitions and open air concerts.
- New cafe/restaurant. The building is designed to integrate with the existing townscape and provide a sensitive addition to the castle environs.
- Steps between the Concourse and The mount. The intention to recreate the pathway route from Nott's Square to Spilman Street is important to complete full access around the Castle environs. The Phase 4 works will maintain the use of quality materials in keeping with this significant scheduled ancient monument.
