

# EIRIAS HIGH SCHOOL COLWYN BAY

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Eirias High School is a large secondary school providing educational facilities to 1300 students, aged 11 to 18. The school has developed and expanded over many years, with a variety of building types. TACP were appointed by Conwy County Borough Council (CCBC) to undertake a Feasibility Study to review possible improvements and enhancements to the school premises, utilising Welsh Assembly SPIG funding.

Working with Conwy County Borough Council, the Feasibility Study established the requirement to replace an existing three-storey building with a new extension to provide new technology, science, general teaching and learning resource spaces, within a high quality flexible development.

The proposals have been carefully considered to ensure the school maintains its current educational provision during the construction phase. The proposals provide enhanced external spaces for pupils within a large central courtyard.
