CATHETERISATION LABORATORY NORTH WALES

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Following the need to expand the cardiology services in North Wales, a new Catheterisation Laboratory has been designed for the Trust, and was completed in 2006. The facilities are situated within the ground floor of a new two-storey development.

The first floor of the new building provides additional teaching accommodation for the North Wales Clinical School, to cater for increased numbers of student nurses and doctors entering the profession.

Externally the modern facades of the new building reflect the sophisticated medical activities taking place within the main laboratory. As part of TACP interiors department's ongoing involvement at Glan Clwyd Hospital, this scheme has made use of form and colour to create a refreshing approach to both public and clinical spaces. The open minded approach of the hospital staff has been integral in allowing the implementation of a bold and stimulating scheme.
