

# THE ORTHOPAEDIC RESEARCH FOR CHILDREN CENTRE (TORCH) GOBOWEN, NORTH WALES

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Following the original launch of the TORCH appeal in 2002, over £4 million was raised to provide the capital funding for a new facility to assess and treat children with mobility problems. The new centre was successfully opened in 2008, and carries out diagnosis and treatment of rare inherited neuromuscular disorders, and develops new techniques to improve mobility and independence of physically disabled children.

The building has a modern, spacious gait laboratory at ground floor level, and research facilities at first floor level which link to the full existing Orthopaedics research building (ARC), to enable full integration with existing facilities. Extensive use of artwork throughout the building helps to give a relaxing and child-friendly interior.
