PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Galliford Try appointed TACP as architects for their submission to the Welsh Assembly Government, for the new North Wales Headquarters building at Llandudno Junction.

The objectives were to create a landmark building that would form a physical identity for the Welsh Assembly Government in North Wales, and also to create a home for National Government in Wales, encouraging strong accessible links with the North Wales community.

The underlying approach is the principle of 'A Vision for Wales'. This concept emphasises the ideology of a forward-looking government which has its focus on Wales and the Welsh community.

The design creates a focus on the primary high-quality views from the site, and ensures the building generates maximum visual connection with both the view and key local landmarks. The Team was shortlisted for this project.
