

# PLAS MWYNWYR (MINERS INSTITUTE - "STIWT") RHOSLLANERCHRUGOG, WREXHAM

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The STIWT was erected in 1926 to house the performing arts hall, library, and administration offices of the village with all the money being raised by the local mining community. The building was abandoned in 1977 and soon after fell into decay. With the aid of local charities, the European Architectural Heritage, CADW and a National Lottery grant of £2.3million pounds, the building has been restored to incorporate a 600 seat theatre, cinema, bars and multi function room facilities for the local community use.
