

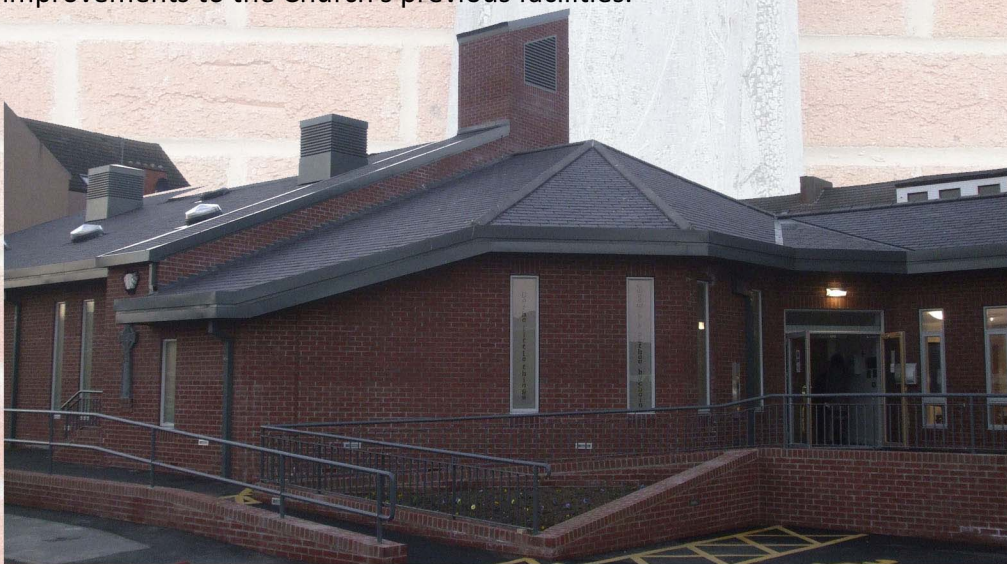
CANOLFAN DEWI SANT CENTRE PENSARN, NORTH WALES

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Completed in 2011 the Canolfan Dewi Sant centre is a sustainable replacement to the existing inadequate church structure. The centre comprises of a worship area, multipurpose hall, cafe/bistro and ancillary accommodation. The main worship area seats up to 30 members, but by opening the bi-folding doors to the main hall, this capacity can be increased to accommodate a greater audience. Flexibility and varied spaces such as the meeting rooms, craft areas and IT rooms offer welcome amenities to the local community.

Sustainability was a key design factor for the building and this consists of sun pipes, air source heat pumps, under floor heating, wind catchers and solar panels. Combined with high insulation levels, low energy lighting and the use of natural lighting and ventilation all contribute to reduce the energy consumption of the centre.

Funded through the Big Lottery, the Welsh Assembly's Community Facilities and Activities Programme, WREN, the Church in Wales and other grant funders, this is an important community centre that offers much needed improvements to the Church's previous facilities.
