

HOLYWELL COMMUNITY HOSPITAL HOLYWELL

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Holywell Community Hospital, opening in March 2008, replaces two existing, ageing hospitals in Holywell and integrates all of the community services into one building. Built on a steeply sloping site, the layout and massing takes full advantage of the views over the estuary and helps create sheltered, private external space. The new hospital comprises of two twenty two-bed wards, a day hospital and therapies department at first floor level with doctors' surgeries, dental, health clinic, x-ray, outpatients, minor injuries and support facilities at ground floor level.

The building is designed to minimize its visual impact on the existing landscape and is constructed in the local vernacular to blend in with the surrounding area. The sloping nature of the site allows the first floor wards to have direct access to sheltered external seating areas at the rear of the building.
