

LAPAROSCOPIC THEATRES AND UROLOGY GLAN CLWYD HOSPITAL, NORTH WALES

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

These two schemes were rolled up into one fast track £2.5 million project that was completed and successfully handed over in 2009, which was just 10 months from the initial client briefing meeting. This was made possible by close liaison with the Trust's framework contractor and complex phasing of the works. The new developments were formed in the middle of the existing main hospital building and no patient services were disrupted throughout the process.

The project included the temporary relocation of the Urology and EBME Departments during the initial phases. The Urology Department was completed first in July 2009 and comprised of consulting areas, Lithotripsy, Trus Biopsy, Ultrasound and a Daycase recovery area. The Operating Theatres scheme consisted of two new Laparoscopic Theatres with all the ancillary accommodation including Dirty Utilities, Anaesthetic, Recovery and also a new Endoscope Steriliser facility.
