

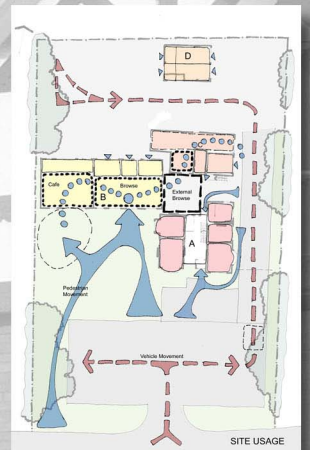
GLYN WYLFA REDEVELOPMENT CHIRK

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Glyn Wylfa Development is a project lead by a community trust, which was established to redevelop the vacant former council buildings. The project involves the assessment of the existing four buildings and designs to redevelop the site for mixed use.

The site benefits from being within the World Heritage Site Buffer Zone and will act as a tourism hub with café, information centre supported by lettable office space and craft workshops. The project is partly funded by the Big Lottery Fund with assistance from Wrexham Borough County Council.

The project also involved the preparation of documentation and presentation material for community consultation.
