

LLYN BRENIG VISITOR CENTRE CERRIGYDRUDION, NORTH WALES

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water, through the North Wales Cycling Centre of Excellence Project, intend to undertake a programme of improvements to the Visitor Centre. The work is funded through the European Regional Development Fund and administered by the Welsh Government.

TACP Architects have provided full architectural services for the project, which will expand and modernise the visitor cafe and terrace. The proposals provide for a new cycle hire and cyclist support centre, along with a dedicated fishing shop and angling information point.

TACP Architects were also appointed to explore further enhancement opportunities and provide a concept masterplan for the site. The masterplan provides additional car parking, opportunities for a cycle track through the woods, lake-side boardwalks and fishing pegs, a shelter for future events and an expanded children's play area.
