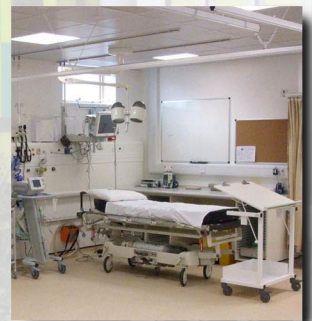


# NEW EMERGENCY RESPONSE AREA WREXHAM MAELOR HOSPITAL

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This challenging project involved the complete refurbishment of, and extension to, the existing busy Accident and Emergency Department, which was fully operational at all times. Through close liaison with the users, Estates Department and the contractor, a series of seven phased developments took place, and the new Emergency Response Area project was completed and successfully handed over to the Trust in 2010.

The department is situated within an existing 'Nucleus' template, which was extended to provide a new Reception area, Waiting and Out-of-Hours. There was also the creation of a new Clinical Decision Unit, Paediatric area and Minor Injuries. The Major Injuries and Resuscitation areas were enlarged. As part of the project Medical Admissions Unit, Cardiology and Coronary Care Unit were integrated and upgraded within the department, and a dedicated new 'blue light' access road and drop-off were formed.
