

ST CHAD'S CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL RUNCORN

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

St Chad's Catholic and Church of England High School and Language College in Runcorn serves the local community with a school population of 950 students, including a sixth form.

TACP's commission included preparation of a strategic development plan and full architectural services. The project was completed in five sections under a single contract. These included:

- Remodelling of the entrance to provide a new entrance and Learning Resource Centre
- New Sports Hall with changing facilities, fitness suite and viewing gallery
- New Science Block with eight laboratories and sixth form suite
- Remodelled Sports Hall to provide Assembly Hall with full stage facilities and retractable seating and new multi-use studio
- Remodelled Science Block to provide music and drama suite with pastoral care suite

The new-build elements were subject to BREEAM assessment, both gaining the required 'Very Good' ratings. Through careful design, the five elements of the project interact with each other to enhance the overall school and improve the existing school facilities and circulation.
