

CENTRE FOR THE CHILD WREXHAM

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Centre for the Child provides unique pre-school education facilities in Britain. The project combines a child care facility for 90 pre-school children aged 6 months to 5 years, with university and private sector learning facilities.

The project includes extensive external play areas, a sensory room, age-appropriate child care areas and support facilities for the child care area. The university education spaces include observation, training areas and seminar rooms.

The design provides a central flexible break-out space servicing all the child care spaces. Each child care space provides direct access to two external play areas which cater for both non-walking and walking age groups.

The project was subject to Welsh Assembly BREEAM requirements, achieving an Excellent rating in reduction of energy use.
