

# PHARMACY, WREXHAM MAELOR HOSPITAL WREXHAM

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The new two-storey pharmacy at Wrexham Maelor Hospital, opened in December 2007, is a state-of-the-art building, incorporating some of the most advanced automation facilities in the country. At the heart of the Pharmacy is an automated drug storage and retrieval robot, which has significantly improved the service to the Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board. The pharmacy has a carefully controlled environment for the storage of drugs, and is designed to the highest security standards.

At the first floor level is a new Aseptic Suite, for the preparation of Cytotoxic and other specialist drugs, in a specialised clean environment, using the most modern gassing sterilisation isolators available. There is a QA/QC laboratory to oversee the quality control of the drug manufacturing process. A number of specialist information areas for consultants, seminar rooms and meeting rooms are located at the first floor level. Storage facilities, together with a dispensary and patient waiting area, are at ground floor level. A new access road and external service area also formed part of the project.
